The 8th edition of [Conecta Fiction & Entertainment](#), a professional market that connects industry, talent, fiction and entertainment from Europe and America, starts on June 18th in Toledo, Spain. This year the event will have Brazil, representing the Americas, and Portugal, representing Europe, as honored countries.

"It is an honor to participate in this event and debate cultural and commercial perspectives, in addition to sharing information about the content that is being produced here, as we know – and know – the potential of Brazilian talents", says Rachel do Valle, program director at Projeto Paradiso and guest at the event to mediate lectures focusing on Brazilian themes.

Vânia Lima, member of the Paradiso Talent Network, also participates in Conecta Fiction, with the support of the Brasil no Mundo program, from Projeto Paradiso. Lima, who is the director of the series project "Fim de Ano", produced by Keyti Souza, from Têm Dendê Produções, and scripted by Daniel Arcades, is one of those selected to participate in the Pitch Copro Series, aimed at series or miniseries with potential for international coproduction. The director and producer will be in Toledo.

More than 30 Brazilian professionals are participating in Conecta Fiction, which will run until the 21st. Among the confirmed Brazilian speakers are representatives from channels and platforms such as Globoplay, Warner Bros., Discovery, Disney and TV Cultura. Production companies such as Gullane Entretenimento, Boutique Filmes, Ventre Studio, O2 Filmes and Glaz Entretenimento, among others, in addition to BRAVI, an association that groups more than 600 independent producers from all over Brazil, and CQS/FV Advogados, are also present.
